The Lakeshore District offers the opportunity to honor Adult Scouters with Special recognition at the yearly Lakeshore District Banquet. ## Individual AWARDS

**DISTRICT AWARD OF MERIT** – presented to Scouters who render service of an outstanding nature on the District level.

**EXTRA MILE SCOUTER AWARD** – presented to adult Scouters who live, eat, and breathe scouting and go way beyond the “one hour per week” commitment to help Scouts achieve their goals.

**FAMILY SCOUTING AWARD** – presented to an entire family who participate together in Scouting for their outstanding service to the Lakeshore District, and for setting the example for youth and living as Scouts in their everyday lives.

**LAKESHORE DISTRICT LEADERSHIP AWARD** – presented in recognition of outstanding and significant District Level Leadership in the Lakeshore District BSA organization.

**LAKESHORE DISTRICT OUTREACH AWARD** – presented to Scouters who exemplify a desire to make Scouting a reality for inner city/rural, or hard to serve youth. Making Scouting available to ALL.

**ROOKIE OF THE YEAR AWARD** – presented to a Scouter who has registered within the past 2 years. This person exhibits outstanding Scouting Spirit, commitment to a Quality Program and made a significant impact on the Scouts within his/her unit. This leader must be trained according to BSA Guidelines.

**SCOUTING PROMISE AWARD** – this award is presented to the Pack, Troup, or Crew that exemplifies a true Quality Program. Quality programs are those that have great retention of their youth, Quality trained leadership, advancement, year round programming and overall Unity Leadership in the Lakeshore District.

**SCOUTING SPIRIT AWARD** – presented to an adult Scouter for outstanding enthusiasm and Scouting Spirit shown each day of his/her life.

**SINGLE PARENT SCOUTER AWARD** – presented to a single parent Scouter who is a true credit to the BSA, and to the ideals that we as Scouts hold close to our hearts. A Scouter who puts forth the effort of two parents and encompasses the larger family of the Scouting community.

**(SILENT) SUPPORTIVE SPOUSE AWARD** – presented to those under-appreciated and often forgotten spouses who make it possible for us to take the time to touch the Scouts around us.

## Unit AWARDS

**ADVANCEMENT AWARD OF EXCELLENCE** – presented to the **Cub Scout Units** that achieve 90% rank advancement between June 1, 2008 and May 31, 2009, based on their roster as of June 1, 2008.

- Presented to **Boy Scout Units** that achieve 75% rank advancement between January 1 and December 31, 2008, based on their roster as of January 1, 2008.

**BEST UNIT WEBSITE** – presented to the unit website that best demonstrates what Scouting has to offer. The website provides accurate and interesting information, is easy to navigate, and visually attractive. The website promotes participation in the local Scouting Community.

**LAKESHORE COMMUNITY SUPPORTERS AWARD** – presented to professional organizations that give extra service to the Lakeshore District.

**MOST INVOLVED CHARTERED ORGANIZATION** – presented to a Chartering Organization that shows a high level of involvement and support in the Scouting community. The Chartered Organization Representative attends monthly District and Unit Committee meetings. The Organization provides meeting facilities and resources to deliver an effective Scouting program. The Organization includes Scouting as a part of its overall program for youth and families.

**MOST SCOUTING FOR FOOD GATHERED** – presented to the units collecting the most food items per registered scout.

**TOP POPCORN SELLING UNIT** – presented to the units selling the most popcorn per registered scout.
