

Outing for Scouting

Troop and Pack Requirements for Camping and Activities

Troop Responsible for:

- 1) Be sure to reserve your campsite for this event.
- 2) Meet with a Webelos II den leader and boys and ask them to join you in a camping adventure, overnight on Friday night of the event.
- 3) Please use all the rules and regulation of Boy Scouts that pertain to Webelos II overnight.
- 4) We want you to hold two outdoor skill instruction sessions with the boy and their adult partner who is attending the activity with them. Suggestion, one held in September and one in October. See attached instruction recommendations.
- 5) There is a training form that is to be filled out and turned in when you register at the event. The purpose is to track you and the boys for the assessment purpose of the Webelos to Scout Transition phase. The patch process is explained on another page.
- 6) Troop is provide breakfast and sack lunch on Saturday for their quests.

Webelos II Leader Responsible for:

- 1) Be ready to join a troop for an overnight camping adventure if you are asked. If you are not asked by a troop please let me know.
- 2) Make sure your Webelos are registered with council. The adult partner that is attending the event may also need to be registered.
- 3) We highly recommend 2 outdoor camping skills instruction with the troop instructor for the Webelos and adult partner. It is essential to a good camping experience. Make sure the training form is filled out and ready to turn in when you register at the event. The purpose is tracking of the boys for attaining patches now and in the future. The patch process will be explained on another page.
- 4) The Webelos II have the option of staying for the pig roast and Finale Fire Bowl of 2010 on Saturday Night of the event at no cost.
