

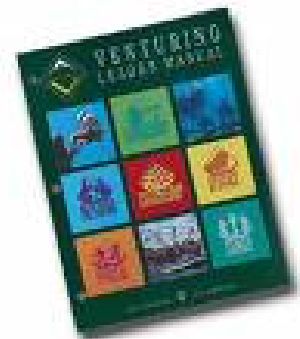


Venturing Adult Leader Specific Training

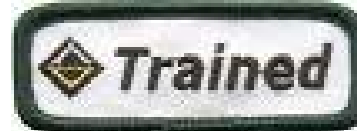
